

## FRANKLIN VETS REFERRAL SURGERY PRICE LIST

### Important note

**These prices are guidelines only.** Every case is unique, and the initial diagnosis and treatment plan may alter in time and when the case arrives for surgery.

**Please ensure this is made clear to the owners before referral.**

A more accurate estimate range can be provided after radiographic examination and a telephone discussion before referral, but a final estimate for treatment and aftercare will be given before surgery when the animal is presented to the surgery team.

Note that in almost all cases, these prices include full blood workup and post-operative medications. In many cases (e.g. cruciates with tibial plateau levelling) x-rays will be needed before the surgery, but these are included in the estimates.

### Orthopaedic surgery

#### Fracture repair

Range of treatment options from intramedullary pinning to external skeletal fixation and locking and non-locking plating. Includes long bone, pelvic, and mandibular fractures.

#### Joint surgery

- OCD shoulder \$3000-3500
- OCD stifle \$3000-3300
- Hock ligament reconstruction +/- arthrodesis \$3000-5500
- Pancarpal arthrodesis \$4500-6000
- Cruciate surgery (note that not all procedures are possible in all patients. Choice of which procedure is made after discussion with the client and obtaining diagnostic x-rays)
  - Extracapsular nylon \$3000-3700
  - TPLO \$5000-6500
  - Additional charges apply if other ligaments are damaged or patellar luxation
- Multi-ligament stifle reconstruction
  - Dog \$5000-7000
  - Cat \$3000-5000
- Medial patella luxation small breed (wedge or block recession trochleaplasty with tibial tuberosity transposition, capsular release, etc)
  - Single leg \$3500-4100
  - Bilateral MPL surgery single session \$5000-6000
- Elbow dysplasia (note that large fragments of bone always have to be removed via arthrotomy, even if the elbow has arthroscopy first)
  - Includes subtotal coronoidectomy, OCD flap removal \$3000-3500

- Open hip reduction and stabilisation for luxation
  - Cat \$2500-3000
  - Dog \$3000-3500
- Forequarter or coxofemoral amputation
  - Cat \$2500-2700
  - Dog \$3100-3400
- Revisional surgery for non-union, including bone grafting \$4000-6000

## Soft tissue surgery

- Total ear canal ablation with lateral bulla osteotomy \$3500-4500
  - Bilateral in one surgery \$5500-6500
- Cancer surgery, including skin flaps, axial pattern flaps, etc \$1500-4000
- Wound management (price on application)
- GDV \$3500-6000
- Intestinal surgery \$1800-4000
  - Gastrotomy medium-sized dog \$3400-3600
  - Enterectomy and anastomosis \$4100-4500
  - Prophylactic gastropexy \$2000-2300
- Thoracotomy \$3000-6000
- Perineal hernia repair \$3100-3500
  - Bilateral repair in one surgery \$3800-4500
- Perineal urethrostomy \$2500-3000
- Nephrectomy \$3000-4000
- Diaphragmatic hernia repair \$3000-4000
- Soft palate resection and wedge resection nostrils \$3300-3600
- Abdominal organ biopsy via laparotomy \$3200-3600
- Partial/complete hepatic lobe resection for neoplasia \$3000-5000
- Anal sac removal \$1700-2000
- Salivary gland removal \$2900-3500
